As PASSED in regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at Seattle, Washington:

WHEREAS: Ballard-Cochran Post 40 has an outstanding Member in JAMES H. ROBINSON,

WHEREAS: James Robinson has diligently served the American Legion for a total of nine (9) years, first for two (2) in Post 110, and seven (7) years as a Member of Ballard-Cochran Post40,

WHEREAS: James Robinson has twice served as Senior Vice Commander of Ballard-Cochran Post 40,

WHEREAS: James Robinson has served as COMMANDER of Ballard-Cochran Post 40 for five (5) consecutive years,

WHEREAS: James Robinson SUCCESSFULLY represented Ballard-Cochran Post 40 against Department of Washington in a Sub Committee Hearing to cancel Ballard-Cochran Post 40's American Legion Charter for allegedly "Conduct Unbecoming a Legionnaire,

WHEREAS: James Robinson SUCCESSFULLY filed a Petition in 2017 in Washington State Superior Court to force American Legion Department of Washington to transparently disclose its Corporate Records to Mr. Robinson, which resulted in a Court Order ORDERING American Legion Department of Washington to DISCLOSE its Corporate Records to REGULAR MEMBERS of the American Legion Department of Washington in accordance with the Laws of the State of Washington,

WHEREAS: James Robinson HONORABLY served his country in the United States Marine Corps for just under six (6) years, first Enlisting as a Private, then receiving a Direct Commission, where he served as an Atomic Artillery Officer and Executive Officer of 1<sup>st</sup> 8 Inch Atomic Artillery Battery (Self Propelled),

WHEREAS: James Robinson GRADUATED as an undergraduate with honors from (now) Foster School of Business, University of Washington with a Concentration in Finance and a Minor in Mathematics,


WHEREAS: James Robinson GRADUATED with a DOCTORATE (JD) from Seattle University, School of Law,


WHEREAS: James Robinson successfully worked as an Investment Banker with First Winthrop of Boston and as a Partner with Salomon Brothers of New York,
