## District 3 Mid-Winter Report

East to West, South to North, the Third District is over 1.5 Million acres of diversified community involvement. From hosting weekly "Breakfast Burritos for Veterans", Film Festivals, Summer Arts Camps, Roller Skating nights, Quilts of Valor Sewing Days, scholarships and awards to recognize high school students.

Our posts sponsored Scouting units, provided Flag Lines and Color Guards to celebrate fellow veterans as they transferred to the Post Everlasting Post Service Officers provided veterans and their families in finding respective County benefits and VA benefits.

Our Leaders ensured 100% Buddy Checks, provided presentations on the availability of the American Legion Family scholarships, provided high school students information on Vietnam. Post Service Officers helped veterans and family members to find different County and VA benefits to delicious holiday dinner meals, our district works to help their community. When one of the counties within our boundaries needed to have a radio booster station maintained the local American Legion post stepped up to ensure community Law Enforcement and Fire assets had 100% continuity.

We have one Post at 111% of their membership goal (missing the New Years Eve goal by three days). One SAL Squadron has 40 members, the #1 squadron in the Detachment.

Over 50% of our posts are now involved on the annual "Wreaths Across America" event with their local cemeteries.
